Dear Mr. Korney:

We have reviewed references (a) through (c), submitted by your email dated December 22, 2015 (MSC Document No.1520347), requesting U. S. Coast Guard type approval of your MAGS MV8.0 and MAGS V8.0 shipboard incinerators. We have found that your incinerators meet the specifications of 46 CFR 63.25-9 and IMO Resolution MEPC.244(66). Accordingly, we hereby issue enclosures (1) and (2).

This certification remains valid for five years from January 6, 2016, unless we suspend, withdraw, or terminate it. Only the manufacturer of the incinerator may apply for this approval to be renewed by writing to the Marine Safety Center (MSC) before it expires. If it is no longer produced, the incinerator continues to be considered certified based on the date of manufacture, the vessel installation date, and a valid approval for that time period. You cannot transfer this approval to another manufacturer without written authorization from the MSC. You must notify the MSC in writing when you make any change in the design or construction of these devices.
